To Whom It May Concern:

I am honoured to commend to you the Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary and the very important ministry they carry out on behalf of refugees and their families.

The Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary have for decades diligently worked with the Refugee Office of the Diocese of London in helping refugees to settle in Canada. In particular, they have made possible the reunification of refugees with family members that they had to leave behind. Since refugees generally lack the resources necessary to cover the costs of transporting their families to Canada, the Sisters, through their Refugee Fund, cover these costs, which can be substantial. They also run a refugee shelter in Windsor, *Angela Rose House*, for newly arrived refugees.

The Refugee Ministries could not provide excellent assistance to refugees in need without the assistance of the Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary Refugee Fund.

By way of this letter, I ask that you be as generous as possible in your donation to the Sisters' Refugee Fund and to the continued support and care they offer to refugees and their families.
